
Why Size Matters in the Virtual Classroom

If your goal is to deliver information but not necessarily enable learners to act on that information, then enroll as many people as you like. They can watch a recording when they need to get some background information, and then move on.

But, if you want your learners to be able to apply what they've learned in a meaningful way and be able to evaluate that learning, a large class size is not the way to go. If you wouldn't do it in the "real classroom," you shouldn't do it in the virtual classroom either.
